PSAC Local 610 awards multiple scholarships every year to members who demonstrate excellence in the areas of academic achievement, community involvement, and outstanding contributions to research.

PSAC 610 Academic Achievement Scholarship

These are awarded once a year to members in good standing of PSAC 610. There are 16 scholarships available: 4 for each academic division. The scholarship, worth \$400, is awarded to 8 Masters and 8 Doctoral students on the basis of academic achievement and research excellence.

PSAC 610 Outstanding Research Contributions Scholarship

These are awarded once a year to members in good standing of PSAC 610. There are 4 scholarships available, worth \$400, for 2 Masters and 2 Doctoral students who have demonstrated outstanding contributions to research in their respective fields whose achievement may have taken the form of, but are not limited to, conference presentations, published articles, workshops, and exhibitions.

PSAC 610 Community Involvement Scholarship

These are awarded once a year to members in good standing of PSAC 610. There are 4 scholarships available, worth \$500, for 2 Masters and 2 Doctoral students who illustrate a high level of involvement with organizations that contribute productively to the community (internal or external to Western).

*Please note, the amounts may vary. *

Application Procedure:

The application procedure consists of 4 parts:

- 1. Completed Application form**
Complete the attached Cover Page and application form.
- 2. Curriculum Vitae (CV)**
Please attach a copy of your Curriculum Vitae plus the front pages of all the publications listed, conference paper acceptance letters, conference programs, exhibition invites, music programs, etc. Please do not add duplicated or very similar publications.
- 3. Graduate Transcript**
Please attach an up-to-date copy of your UWO graduate program transcript and other graduate program transcripts from OTHER INSTITUTIONS, if any. Unofficial copies are acceptable. Undergraduate marks will not be considered."
- 4. Required Documents**
Please attach relevant documents such as proof of scholarships/awards, publications, presentations, workshops, performances, exhibitions, letter from community organizations, (internal or external to UWO), etc.

Teaching Assistant members may apply for all 3 GTA scholarships using this single application; Postdoc members may apply only for the PD scholarship. This PD scholarship has its own separate application form. Email psac610@psac610.ca for details. The scholarship committee will consist of representation from the 5 divisions. The applications are confidential and blinded for the committee. Applicants will be notified by email about the results and the successful applications will be announced in PSAC 610's bulletin.

To ensure full consideration of your application, please submit all the requested supporting documents (i.e., transcripts, front pages of publications, proof of conference presentations, letters attesting to community involvement, etc.). Completed applications (Part 1-4) must be submitted by April 15, 2017 to PSAC Local 610 (address above).
